Hiram Walker was an American businessman who during the mid 1800's crossed the Detroit River into Ontario, Canada and built a whiskey distillery. The company began successfully producing whiskey labeled as Hiram Walker's Club Whiskey. It became very popular but American distillers became disenchanted with the name and so the US Government passed a law requiring that all foreign whiskeys state their country of origin on the label. This resulted in the production and then steady increase in sales of what was renamed, Hiram Walker's Canadian Club Whiskey. This product remains a well recognized brand of whiskey today.

The Distillery Processing Environment

Distilling whiskey involves mashing and fermentation. This process creates a wet environment and exceptionally

slippery floors. The floors are subjected to spills as well as the continuous activity of fork lifts and other wheeled equipment in the warehouse portion of the facility. Their current tile floor was not chemical or impact resistant and the surface was worn and slippery. The Hiram Walker decision makers wanted a floor with a textured surface to protect against spills and they sought a long-lasting solution and solid return on investment. Finally the company had only five days of shutdown time to allow for installation of the new floor.
